STATEMENT OF THE CASE

- APPLICANT

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order approving an 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 1, Township 26 South, Range 31 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the E/2E/2 of Section 1 for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit will be dedicated to the Big Sinks 1 A2PA Fed. Com.
