To Whom It May Be Concerned,

I am in receipt of Chevron's letter dated July 22, 2014, which was delivered to my office on July 24, 2014, in which Chevron USA Inc. requests to surface commingle oil, gas, and water at Chevron's Gramma Ridge Battery.

Crown Oil Partners V, LP (fka Crown Oil Partners IV, LP) and Crump Energy Partners II, LLC (fka Crump Energy Partners, LLC) do hereby object to the surface commingling of all wells in Section 14 proposed by Chevron USA Inc. While we recognize the need to reduce costs and minimize surface disturbance, both Crown Oil Partners V, LP and Crump Energy Partners II, LLC, do not have ownership in the east half of the section.

Therefore, we believe it would be in the best interest of all owners to build a facility for the well(s) on the West half of Section 14 and a separate facility the well(s) on the East half of Section 14. Based on past experience, we do not believe that an accurate allocation of monthly sales volumes for each well can be generated by well testing.

Crown and Crump would not object to commingling the wells on the West half of the Section in one tank battery and wells on the East half of the Section in a separate tank battery.
