



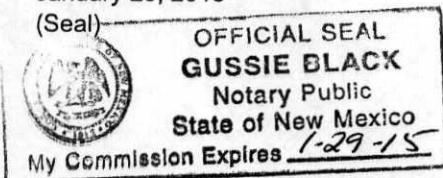

## LEGAL NOTICE November 6, 2014

### NOTICE

To: Anna M. Chaffin, Joseph R. Bachman, and Anna Marguerite Bachman Chaffin, or your heirs, devisees, or successors: JLA Resources Company has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit in the Devonian formation (Southwest Gladiola-Devonian Pool) comprised of the SW/4NW/4 of Section 1 and SE/4NE/4 of Section 2, Township 13 South, Range 37 East, N.M.P.M. Lea County, New Mexico, approving an unorthodox oil well location in the Devonian formation, and pooling all mineral interests in the Devonian formation underlying the non-standard unit. Applicant proposes to drill the Kinsolving 2 Well No. 1 at a location 1750 feet from the north line and 30 feet from the east line of Section 2, to a depth sufficient to test the Devonian formation, and will dedicate the SW/4NW/4 of Section 1 and SE/4NE/4 of Section 2 to the well. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Sojourner Drilling Corporation as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, November 20, 2014 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date.
