#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

## APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 16, Township 19 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Cimarron State 16-19S-34E RN Well No. 134H, a horizontal well with a surface location in the NE/4NE/4, and a terminus in the SE/4SE/4, of Section 16. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Matador Production

Company as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
