2 EXAMINER GOETZE: Good morning, ladies and
3 gentlemen. This is a special Examiners Hearing for
4 Tuesday, December 9th, 2014, Docket Number 37-14, in
5 Porter Hall, Santa Fe, New Mexico. Today's special
6 hearing is about three cases involving saltwater
7 disposal wells and their authority to inject. The three
8 cases -- two will be consolidated, but we'll start off
9 with Case 15192, application of BOPCO, L.P. for the
10 revocation of the injection authority granted under
11 Administrative Orders SWD-12 -- SWD-1269 and SWD-649-B,
12 Eddy County, New Mexico.

13 Call for appearances.

14 MR. LARSON: Good morning, Mr. Examiner.
15 Gary Larson of Hinkle Shanor in Santa Fe for BOPCO L.P.

16 EXAMINER GOETZE: Very good.

17 Any other appearances?

18 Proceed, Mr. Larson.

19 MR. LARSON: This is a case that BOPCO had
20 entered into a stipulation with Mesquite whereby
21 Mesquite agreed to the entry of an order revoking its
22 injection authority under the two administrative orders
23 you just cited. We submitted an unopposed motion to the
24 Division, which attached the stipulation, and requested
25 that an order be entered revoking Mesquite's injection

1 authority for those two SWD wells.

2 EXAMINER GOETZE: And there has been no
3 other opposition from Mesquite since we've had the
4 submission of the motion for entry?

5 MR. LARSON: No, there has not been.

6 EXAMINER GOETZE: So we will stand with the
7 motion for entry?

8 MR. LARSON: Yes, sir.

9 EXAMINER GOETZE: Do you have a question?

10 EXAMINER JONES: You asked that the
11 settlement be incorporated into the order that the
12 Division writes?

13 MR. LARSON: Not necessarily. I was
14 actually requested to draft a proposed order, and I
15 think that has the terms we thought would be necessary
16 for the order.

17 EXAMINER GOETZE: Any questions, Counsel?

18 EXAMINER WADE: No questions from me.

19 EXAMINER GOETZE: Very well. Then we will
20 take Case 15192 under advisement.


