#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

COG's application seeks an order (i) approving a 240-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 NW/4 of Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 28 East and the E/2 W/2 of Section 28, Township 26 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, in Eddy County, and (ii) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this average. The proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Graham Nash Fed Com #7H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 NW/4 (Lot 2) of Section 33, Township 26 South, Range 28 East to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 28, Township 26 South, Range 28 East. The completed interval for this well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
