COG's application seeks an order (i) approving a 200-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 NE/4 of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 35 East and the W/2 SE/4 of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., in Lea County, and (ii) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this average. The proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Skull Cap State Com #2H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the W/2 SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 35 East to a bottom hole location in the W/2 SE/4 (Unit J) of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 35 East. The completed interval for this well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
