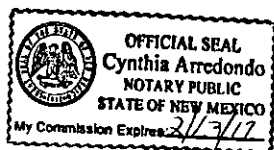

To: James Kirby Read, Jr. Individually and as Personal Representative of the Estates of Joella Cox, Virginia Meador, and Lovella Read, or their successors, heirs, devisees, or assigns: Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the S/2N/2 of Section 22, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the S/2N/2 of Section 22 for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit will be dedicated to the Grand 22 Well No. 2H, a horizontal well with a surface location 1360 feet from the north line and 255 feet from the west line, and a terminus 2265 feet from the north line and 330 feet from the east line, of Section 22. Also to be considered will be the designation of applicant as operator of the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, June 25, 2015 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 2 miles north-northwest of Otis, New Mexico.
