COG's application requests an order (i) approving a 160-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 12, Township 23 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., in Lea County, and (ii) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage. The proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for COG's Resolver Federal Com #1H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit D of Section 12, Township 23 South, Range 32 East to a bottom hole location in Unit M of Section 12, Township 23 South, Range 32 East. The completed interval for this well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
