2 EXAMINER GOETZE: We have two cases left.

3 At this point, I would like to go to the last case on
4 the docket, that would be case No. 15322, Application of
5 of Key Energy Resources, LLC, for approval of a salt
6 water disposal well, Eddy County, New Mexico.

7 Call for appearances.

8 MR. LARSON: Good morning, Mr. Examiner.
9 Gary Larson of Santa Fe Office of Hinkle Shanor for the
10 Applicant, Key Energy Resources.

11 EXAMINER GOETZE: Very good. Any other
12 appearances?

13 MR. FELDEWERT: Please, Examiner, Michael
14 Feldewert with the Santa Fe Office of Holland and Hart,
15 appearing on behalf of BC Operating as well as Crown
16 Partners.

17 EXAMINER GOETZE: So it is my understanding
18 that at this point in this case we are looking at the
19 submittal of information?

20 MR. LARSON: That is correct, Mr. Examiner.

21 EXAMINER GOETZE: Thank you.

22 MR. LARSON: May I proceed, Mr. Examiner?

23 EXAMINER GOETZE: Please.

24 MR. LARSON: At the hearing in this case, on
25 August 20th, Key Energy presented testimony regarding

1 four newly identified affected persons with interest
2 within the half-mile radius of the proposed SWD well and
3 the provision of hearing notices to those four entities.

4 Key Energy also tendered its Exhibit No. 28,
5 which was admitted into the record. Exhibit 28
6 identified the names and mailing addresses of the four
7 entities with interest within the area reviewed.

8 And during the hearing, Mr. Wade requested
9 that Key Energy identify the locations of those
10 interests. And, accordingly, I am now tendering for
11 admission Key Energy Exhibit No. 36 which lists the four
12 entities, provides legal descriptions of the locations
13 of their interest, identifies the entities from whom
14 they acquired those interests and designates whether the
15 affected persons are operators and/or lessees.

16 And I move the admission of Key Energy
17 Exhibit 36.

18 EXAMINER GOETZE: Mr. Feldewert.

19 MR. FELDEWERT: I have no objection to the
20 exhibit. I guess I had a couple of questions about the
21 exhibit. I am trying to tie it to their application and,
22 in particular, the tracts that they have identified in
23 their application. So give me one moment.

24 (Pause.)

25 MR. FELDEWERT: I don't have any questions.

1 EXAMINER GOETZE: You do not?

2 MR. FELDEWERT: I do not.

3 EXAMINER GOETZE: Very well. Exhibit 36 is
4 so entered.

5 (Key Energy Exhibit 36 was offered and admitted.)

6 EXAMINER GOETZE: Any closing statement,
7 sir?

8 MR. LARSON: With that, I request the case
9 be taken under advisement and I renew my request that
10 Key Energy's application be granted.

11 EXAMINER GOETZE: Any comments or final
12 statements?

13 MR. FELDEWERT: No. You have the argument
14 from our last hearing.

15 EXAMINER GOETZE: Very good. Then case
16 15322 is taken under advisement.

17 At this point we are going to take a short
18 break and get everybody ready for the last case and we
19 will go from there. So let's take a break. We should
20 be back here at five till nine.
