1. The proposed Unit Area consists of 7038.69 acres, more or less, of State of New Mexico lands, situated in Chaves County, New Mexico. The horizontal limits of said unit are described as follows:

2. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.

4. The unit boundaries are consistent and substantially supported by the

geological limits of the unitized formations.
