WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 8:31 a.m.:

EXAMINER JONES: Continuing, we'll call Case 13,091, Application of Yates Petroleum Corporation for approval of a unit agreement, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Call for appearances in this case.

MR. FELDEWERT: May it please the Examiner, my name is Michael Feldewert with the Santa Fe office of Holland and Hart, appearing on behalf of the Applicant, Yates Petroleum Corporation, and I have no witnesses here today.

EXAMINER JONES: Any other appearances?
There being none, Mr. Feldewert?

MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, if I may approach, I have an affidavit.

EXAMINER JONES: Okay.

MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, Yates is here to present this matter by affidavit in seeking approval of its proposed Humidor State Exploratory Unit, which is comprised of 2444 acres in Eddy County, New Mexico. Yates seeks to be designated the operator of the unit and proposes to test all formations from the surface to the base of the Morrow, with the primary objective of the initial test well to be the middle Morrow sands. This entire unit area is comprised of state land, and Yates is the only lessee.

Now, in support of this Application, they have marked as Exhibit Number 1 the affidavit of Raymond W. Podany. He is the geologist at Yates that's responsible for putting this project in place, and he has attached to his affidavits a number of exhibits.

Exhibit A to his affidavit is the standard state form unit agreement for this proposed Humidor State Exploratory Unit.

Exhibit B is a copy of the plat to the unit agreement that shows the boundaries of the unit area and as well the location of the initial test well.

Exhibit C is a copy of the schedule to the unit agreement that identifies the working interest and then the State's royalty interest in this area.

And then Exhibit D was supposed to be the approval letter from the State Land Office. I was on the phone with Pete Martinez yesterday. He indicated that the State has everything that it needs, that I could represent that they have given preliminary approval. The only problem is, Jami Bailey is on vacation and will not be back until tomorrow. So I hope to have a letter in hand tomorrow, and with your permission I'd like to supplement the record tomorrow with that letter.

And then Exhibit E is a net sand isopach map for the middle Morrow sands which project the sand trends

throughout this area.

And Exhibit F is a north-south cross-section of the middle Morrow sands.

We believe this affidavit and the exhibits demonstrate that the unit covers an area that can be reasonably developed under a unit plan, we believe that approval of this unit will result in the efficient recovery of hydrocarbons, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights, so we ask that Exhibit 1 be admitted into evidence and that the Division allow me to supplement with the State's letter tomorrow, and then take this matter under advisement and issue its order approving the unit.

EXAMINER JONES: Okay, there's some -- within

Exhibit 1 you have Exhibit E, which shows the unit outline,

and it has a bunch of wells already in the unit. Is that

okay with the State Land Office, that there will be -
their letter will show that these are...

MR. FELDEWERT: You're on Exhibit E?

EXAMINER JONES: Yes.

MR. FELDEWERT: Yeah, I'm not sure the status of these wells.

EXAMINER JONES: Okay.

MR. FELDEWERT: I know they were used to develop the cross-section. I'm not sure of the status of these wells.

2	the land department's position on this
3	MR. FELDEWERT: State Land Office, yes.
4	EXAMINER JONES: State Land Office.
5	MR. FELDEWERT: See, Yates actually had a meeting
6	with the State Land Office. They explained the proposed
7	development, provided the information that the State Land
8	Office requested, and like I said, I was on the phone
9	yesterday with Mr. Martinez, who indicated that they had
10	everything they needed and would be issuing preliminary
11	approval.

13	Exhibit 1, which includes Exhibits 1 through E
14	will be admitted into evidence.
15	And I have no further questions.
16	Mr. Brooks?
