This is Docket Number 01-06, Thursday, 4 January 5th, 2006. 5 At this time I'll call the continuances and the 6 7 dismissals. On page 1, Case 13,597 is dismissed; Case 13,603 8 is continued to the 19th of January; Case 13,598 is 9 continued to January 19th. 10 On page 2, Case 13,612 continued to January 19th; 11 Case 13,613 continued to January 19th; and Case 13,614 12 continued to January 19th. 13 On page 3, Case 13,615 continued to January 19th; 14 Case 13,617 continued to January 19th; and Case 13,618 also 15 continued to January 19th. 16 On page 4, Case 13,619, 13,620, 13,621, 13,622, 17 13,623 and 13,624 are all continued to January 19th. 18 And on page 5, Case 13,625 continued to January 19 19th; Case 13,610 is dismissed; and Case 13,578 is also 20 dismissed. 21 22 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner? 23 EXAMINER CATANACH: I'm sorry, Mr. Bruce? 24 MR. BRUCE: Could I ask one thing? One of the 25 cases that was continued -- Excuse me, just for the record,

which is continued.

And if the record could reflect, I'm here with the principals of -- Mr. and Mrs. Ard, the principals of the Ard interests, and with my witness Ron Grappe, although the case is not being heard.

7 Yesterday when we discussed this matter, there was a question about turnover of some data that the Ard 8 interests had previously requested, and I know there's no 9 subpoena on that data, but we had requested it, and I had 10 separately mentioned that to Mr. Carr, and I'd like the 11 record to reflect that if that information is going to be 12 turned over, it would certainly help, the sooner the 13 better, before the next hearing. 14

MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, William F. 15 Carr, I represent the Hudson interest. As we were directed 16 yesterday, we're prepared to meet with Mr. Bruce and review 17 what they need. We won't give proprietary or confidential 18 information, but it looked to me like, from a letter that 19 20 was attached to his response to a motion to quash the 21 subpoena, then, most of that data can be provided, and I'll meet with Mr. Bruce, and we'll quickly get that to the Ard 22 interests. 23

24 MR. BRUCE: There was one -- the geophysical 25 data, and we recognize that the Division does not request
