- 1. By Order No. R-12306-B, issued in this case on August 5, 2005, the Director ordered, *inter alia*, that, "Following filing by GMI [Gandy Marley, Inc.] of a revised application in conformity with Rule 711, and after proper notice thereof is provided, the Director hereby refers this matter directly to the Commission for further proceedings thereon." Ordering paragraph 5 of Order No. R-12306-B.
- 2. Subsequent to the issuance of Order No. R-12306-B, Gandy Marley, Inc. filed a new application and gave the required notices.
- 3. By letter dated December 23, 2005, Controlled Recovery, Inc., which had protested Gandy Marley Inc.'s original application, stated that it would not object to the new application.
- 4. No other party or person has protested Gandy Marley's application in its present form or requested a hearing thereon, and the Division staff recommends approval of the application.
