Re: Case No. 13069; Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, Through the Engineering Bureau Chief, for Adoption of a New Rule Relating to Compulsory Pooling and Prescribing Risk Charges.

Dear Chairman Wrotenbery

At the hearing on June 12, 2003, the Commission requested the undersigned to file two things on or before June 26, 2003:

- 1. excerpts from testimony in a previous case, which the Division proposed to offer on the question of risk charges in the Fruitland Coal Gas Pool; and
- 2. a revised draft of the proposed rule correcting a mistake in the text submitted.

With respect to the first item, after considerable searching, I have been unable to find the testimony in question, and accordingly respectfully request to withdraw the Division's offer of that evidence.

With respect to the second item, I cannot remember the language to which the Commission called my attention as constituting a mistake in the text, and accordingly request an extension of the time to submit a corrected text until Thursday, July 10, 2003, when the transcript of the June 12 hearing will be available.
