APPLICATION

RUBICON OIL & GAS, L.L.C. ("Rubicon"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an order approving its Hightower State Exploratory Unit and in support of this application states:

1. The proposed Unit Area consists of 2,080 acres, more or less, of State of New Mexico lands, situated in Lea County, New Mexico. The horizontal limits of said unit are described as follows:

Township 12 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M.

Section 15: All
Section 22: All
Section 23: NW4
Section 27: All

2. The Unit Agreement has been approved by a sufficient percentage of the interest owners within the proposed Unit Area to provide effective control of unit operations.

3. The Applicant, Rubicon Oil & Gas, L.L.C., is designated as Unit Operator in said Unit Agreement and all oil and gas in all formations are unitized.

4. The unit boundaries are consistent and substantially supported by the geological limits of the unitized formations.

5. Said Unit Agreement and the unitized operation and management of the Unit Area will be in the interest of conservation and the prevention of waste, and it will protect the correlative rights of all parties concerned.

WHEREFORE, Rubicon requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on February 16, 2006, that notice be given as required by law and the rules of the Division, and that the Hightower State Exploratory Unit be approved.
