### **APPLICATION**

Charles D. Ray applies for an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the S½ of Section 5, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the  $S\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 5, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill the Randy State Well No. 1, at an orthodox location in the NW1/4SW1/4 of Section 5, to a depth sufficient to test the Morrow formation, and seeks to dedicate the S1/2 of Section 5 to the well to form a standard 320 acre gas spacing and proration unit for any formations and/or pools developed on 320 acre spacing within that vertical extent.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the  $S\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 5 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the S½ of Section 5, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the S½ of Section 5, as set forth above, will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the  $S\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 5, from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation;
- B. Designating BC Operating, Inc. as operator of the well;
- C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

### PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case No. /3647: Application of Charles D. Ray for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico: Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation underlying the S/2 of Section 5, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be designated to the Randy State Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodox location in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 5. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of BC Operating, Inc. as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 12 miles west-northwest of Tatum, New Mexico.

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
