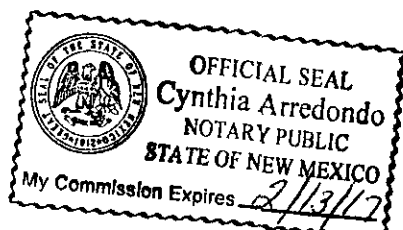

Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Bone Yard 11 Fee No. 11H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) to a standard bottom-hole location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 11. 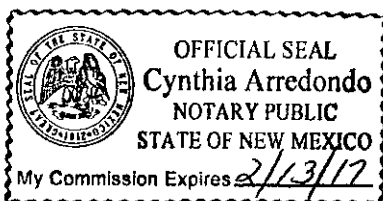
