



Kadane, Brent Ray Robertson, Chris Ann Wills, Otter Creek, Williams Enterprises, David Sorenson, KC Resources, and Plantation Operating LLC, or your heirs, devisees, successors, or assigns: Matador Production Company has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order approving a 154.28-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of Lots 1-4 (the W1/2W1/2) of Section 31, Township 18 South, Range 35 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit (project area) for all pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Airstrip 31 18 35 RN State Com. Well No. 201R, a horizontal well with a surface location in Lot 4, and a terminus in Lot 1, of Section 31. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, September 3, 2015 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit, or as an offset interest owner, you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 15 miles west-northwest of Monument, New Mexico. #30247
