

Thank you for your letter of July 16, 2015 together with a Designation of Successor Unit Sub-Operator dated July 14, 2015 for the Cotton Draw Unit. The document designates Sahara Operating Company as sub-operator in the Cotton Draw Unit encompassing the Delaware Sand Participation Area limited to depths from the surface of the earth to the base of the Delaware formation.

The Commissioner of Public Lands has this date approved the Designation of Sub-Operator. It is our understanding that this Designation of Sub-Operator does not relieve the unit operator of responsibility for compliance with the terms of the unit agreement and all oil and gas regulations. Our approval is subject to like approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation and the Bureau of Land Management.
