Dear Mr. Catanach:

Division Order No. R-14095 granted COG Operating LLC's application for a nonstandard spacing unit and compulsory pooling on December 14, 2015. The order authorized the drilling of COG's Goose State Well No. 2H at a location in the W/2 W/2 of Section 32, Township 20 South, Range 34 East and Lot 1, Lot 8, Lot 9 and Lot 16 of Irregular Section 5. Township 21 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. A copy of the order is enclosed for your convenience.

Ordering Paragraph 6 of Order No. R-14095 requires COG to drill and complete the well within 120 days or the Order will terminate unless COG obtains a time extension from the Division Director for good cause shown. COG spud the well on January 3, 2016 and completed drilling on February 7, 2016. Unfortunately, COG has been unable to begin completion operations on the well. COG plans to construct a frac pond nearby and must obtain a business lease from the New Mexico State Land Office (NMSLO). The NMSLO requires COG to get approval from the grazing lessee where the frac pond is proposed to be located. COG has been unable to get the grazing lessee's approval as of yet but is working diligently to do so. The primary term of the lease where the well is located will expire July 1, 2016. Since COG will need to have the well completed by the primary term deadline. COG respectfully requests an extension until July 1, 2016 to complete the Goose State Well No. 2H.
