WHEREUPON, the following proceedings were had at 1 2 9:15 a.m.: 3 4 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: And we move on to the next 5 case, which is Case Number 13,568, just the next case, and 6 this is the Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation 7 Division for an order requiring Southeastern Petroleum, 8 Inc., to plug two wells and ordering forfeiture of 9 financial assurance. 10 Call for appearances. 11 MR. BROOKS: Mr. Examiner, I'm David Brooks with 12 the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department, 13 appearing for the Oil Conservation Division. 14 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Any other appearances at this 15 point? 16 MR. BROOKS: And I have one witness who's already 17 18 been sworn this morning. 19 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay, now you may proceed. 20 MR. BROOKS: Thank you, Mr. Examiner. 21 Once again, I will begin with the exhibits that do not require the witness's identification. 22 23 OCD Exhibit Number 1 is a copy of my affidavit of 24 notice. It's somewhat longer and more complicated than in 25 the previous case. In this case we did give notice to a

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1	surety.
2	If you will look at the exhibits to my exhibit,
3	Exhibit A to Exhibit 10 [<i>sic</i>] is the OCD's letter to
4	Southeastern Petroleum, Inc., the operator, and to
5	Underwriters Indemnity Company.
6	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Exhibit 10, I can't I
7	don't have it.
8	MR. BROOKS: It should be the first exhibit. I
9	believe it's right there beside you.
10	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay.
11	MR. BROOKS: Okay, Exhibit A to Exhibit 10 is the
12	letter that was sent.
13	Exhibit B is the receipt for certified mail and
14	the a copy of the receipt for certified mail and the
15	green card, indicating that the letter to the surety was
16	delivered and they have received it. That's to
17	Underwriters Indemnity.
18	Exhibit C is the copy of the letter to
19	Southeastern Petroleum, Inc., or it's a copy of the receipt
20	for certified mail to Southeastern Petroleum, Inc., and
21	also a copy of the return the envelope face that was
22	returned to the OCD by the United States Postal Service,
23	indicating that the addressee is unknown.
24	Exhibit D is a copy of two receipts for certified
25	mail. If you will look at the letter, we sent notice to
-	

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Mr. Sunny Longo, who was formerly the principal of 1 Southeastern Petroleum, Inc., at two different addresses 2 that we had for Mr. Longo. These mailings, we have neither 3 gotten a return receipt nor have we received the mailings 4 5 back. Once again, because we didn't think that we could 6 contact Southeastern, we also published notice of this 7 hearing at this time. Because the wells are in Chaves 8 County, the notice was published in the Roswell Daily 9 Record on February 6th, 2006, evidenced by the affidavit of 10 notice attached as Exhibit E to my affidavit of notice. 11 Going on, then, through my exhibits here, OCD 12 Exhibit Number 2 is a copy of the inactive well list 13 showing the two wells -- from the Division's records, 14 showing the two wells that are the subject of this 15 16 proceeding. The Pogo State Number 1 was last produced on July -- in July of 1995, the Pogo State Number 2 in 17 December, 1995. 18 19 Exhibit Number 3 is a copy of a C-104 reflecting 20 transfer of operations for the Pogo State Well Number 1 to 21 Southeastern Petroleum, Inc., from Oilfield Training Center. 22 23 Exhibit Number 4 is a copy of a C-104 reflecting transfer of operations of the Pogo State Well Number 2 from 24 -- to Southeastern Petroleum, Inc., from Oilfield Training 25

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1	Center.
2	Exhibit Number should be Exhibit Number 5. On
3	my copy the exhibit number did not come out, probably
4	because of the edge of the page. It's a legal-size
5	document. Do you have an exhibit mark on your copy?
6	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: No, I don't, I just marked it
7	5.
8	MR. BROOKS: Okay. OCD Exhibit Number 5 is a
9	copy of a single-well plugging bond for \$5000 that relates
10	to the Pogo State Well Number 1.
11	And there is also a plugging bond for the Pogo
12	State Well Number 2. Unfortunately, I do not have that
13	exhibit. That would be bond number Exhibit 5 is bond
14	number B7654. The bond for the Pogo State Well Number 2 is
15	B7655, also from Underwriters Indemnity.
16	I will request the indulgence of the Examiner to
17	supplement the record with a copy of that other bond.
18	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay, I'll take
19	administrative notice of that. It's also for \$5000, for
20	that Well Number 2?
21	MR. BROOKS: That is correct.
22	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay.
23	MR. BROOKS: With that, I will offer Exhibits 1
24	through 5.
25	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Exhibits 1 through 5 will be

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admitted into evidence. 1 MR. BROOKS: At this time I call Mr. Van Barton. 2 EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Go ahead. 3 VAN BARTON (present by telephone), 4 the witness herein, after having been first duly sworn upon 5 his oath, was examined and testified as follows: 6 DIRECT EXAMINATION 7 BY MR. BROOKS: 8 9 Q. Mr. Barton? Yes, sir. 10 Α. You've stated your name and capacity previously, 11 0. but because this is going to be a separate record I'll ask 12 13 you to state your name again. Van Barton. 14 Α. 15 0. And you are the field manager for the Oil Conservation Division in Artesia? 16 17 Field Supervisor, sir. Α. Okay. And Mr. Barton, are you familiar with 18 0. Southeastern Petroleum, Inc.? 19 20 Α. Yes, sir. 21 And is this another case of an operator you've Q. been unable to contact? 22 23 Yes, sir. A. 24 Mr. Barton, are you familiar with the Pogo State Q. 25 Number 1 and the Pogo State Number --

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1	A. Yes, sir.
2	Q wells? And are these wells operated by or
3	last operated by Southeastern Petroleum, Inc.?
4	A. Yes, sir.
5	Q. Mr. Barton, did you prepare plugging procedures
6	for the Pogo Wells Numbers 1 and 2?
7	A. There are plugging procedures that have been
8	prepared under my direction.
9	Q. Okay. Did you e-mail those plugging procedures
10	to me yesterday?
11	A. I did, sir.
12	Q. And if these wells were plugged in accordance
13	with the procedures that you e-mailed to me, on March the
14	1st, 2006, would those wells be properly plugged in
15	accordance with OCD Rules?
16	A. Yes, sir.
17	MR. BROOKS: Okay, I will represent to the
18	Examiner that Exhibits Number 6 and 7 are copies of the
19	plugging procedures that were e-mailed to me yesterday by
20	Mr. Barton.
21	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay, Exhibits 6 and 7 will
22	be admitted into evidence.
23	Q. (By Mr. Brooks) Mr. Barton, did you have you
24	examined the well files for the Pogo State Wells Numbers 1
25	and 2?

1	A. I have.
2	Q. Is there anything in those well files to indicate
. 3	that those wells have been plugged?
4	A. No, sir.
5	Q. Is there anything in those files to indicate that
6	there's ever been a request for those wells to be put in
7	approved temporary abandonment status?
8	A. No, sir.
9	Q. Or that they ever have been put in approved
10	temporary abandonment status?
11	A. There is not.
12	MR. BROOKS: Thank you, I believe that's all my
13	questions.
14	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Thank you.
15	Do you have any questions?
16	MS. O'CONNOR: I have none.
17	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: I don't have any questions,
18	but now here you're asking what different from the
19	other one, you know
20	MR. BROOKS: Well, again, we're asking that the
21	Division enter an order directing Southeastern Petroleum,
22	Inc., to plug these wells by a date certain. That part of
23	it is the same as what we are asking in the other case.
24	In this case, because we have bonds, we're also
25	asking that the order direct that in the event that

1	Southeastern Petroleum, Inc., fails to plug the wells
2	within the date provided, that the bonds be forfeited so
3	that they can be collected by the Division to reimburse the
4	Division for expenses that may be incurred if the Division
5	has to plug these wells.
6	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Thank you, Mr. Brooks.
7	EXAMINATION
8	BY MR. EZEANYIM:
9	Q. Mr. Barton, let me ask you a question again. Do
10	you know whether Southeastern Petroleum Corporation are
11	they still in business?
12	A. I do not know, sir. We were unable to get any
13	response from them, from any known addresses that we had.
14	Q. When you tried to contact them, that were
15	returned to you, right?
16	A. That's correct, sir.
17	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: No further questions.
18	Do you have anything more?
19	MR. BROOKS: Nothing further.
20	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Okay.
21	MR. BROOKS: Other than to supplement the record
22	with a copy of the other bond.
23	EXAMINER EZEANYIM: Yeah, I think we'll get that.
24	At this point, Case Number 13,658 will be taken
25	under advisement.
