Case No. 15369 (re-opened): Application Of Encana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. To Amend Order R-14090 To Expand The Crow Canyon Unit

And The Corresponding Crow Canyon Unit; Mancos Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks to amend Order R-14090 to (1) expand the geographic area of the Crow Canyon Unit by 6,415.47 of Federal and State land; and (2) expand the corresponding Crow Canyon Unit; Mancos Pool created by that Order to allow horizontal wells to be located anywhere within the Unit so long as the completed interval is no closer than 330 feet from the outer boundary of the expanded Crow Canyon Unit area. The proposed expanded Unit Area will consist of approximately 13,631.90 acres of Federal, Indian Allotted, and State lands located in all or parts of the following sections in San Juan County, New Mexico:

Sections 3-5, 8-10, 15-17, 20-21, 28-30, and 34 of T-24-N, R-8-W; and Sections 25-26, 32-36 of T-25-N, R-8-W.

The unitized interval is 100 feet below the stratigraphic equivalent of the top of the Mancos Shale (base of the Mesa Verde Group) to the stratigraphic equivalent of the base of the Greenhorn Limestone, as shown in the Anabel C No. 001 (API No. 30-045-25452) in Section 34, Township 25 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. The subject acreage is located approximately 2 miles Northeast of Nageezi, New Mexico.
