## <u>APPLICATION</u>

Matador Production Company applies for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the W½ of Section 30, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and approving an unorthodox gas well location, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an operator in the W½ of Section 30, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Jim Tom Lontos 30-23S-28E RB Well No. 221H to a depth sufficient to test the Wolfcamp formation (East Black River-Wolfcamp Gas Pool). Applicant seeks to dedicate the well to the W½ of Section 30 to form a standard 320 acre gas spacing and proration unit for all pools or formations developed on 320 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The well is a horizontal well with a surface location 492 feet from the south line and 467 feet from the west line of Section 30. The producing interval will be unorthodox, with the first perforation 330 feet from the south and west lines, and the last perforation 330 feet from the north and west lines, of Section 30
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the W½ of Section 30 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to

the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests.

Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the W½ of Section 30,

pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests underlying the W½ of Section 30, and

approval of the unorthodox well location, will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent

waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its

order:

A. Pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the W½ of

Section 30:

B. Approving the unorthodox gas well location;

C. Designating applicant as operator of the well;

D. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost

among the well's working interest owners;

E. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together

with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

F. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in

the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
