

Applicant further seeks the contraction of the Scanlon Draw-Bone Spring Pool, Turkey Track-Bone Spring Pool, and Parkway-Bone Spring Pool so that they do not include any acreage described above. Finally, applicant seeks special rules and regulations for the pool, including standard 40 acre vertical oil spacing and proration units, standard 320 acre horizontal oil spacing and proration units, special well location requirements for horizontal wells, special depth bracket allowables, and a gas:oil ratio of 10000:1. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, December 3, 2015 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the above acreage you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date.
