#### STATEMENT OF THE CASE

#### **APPLICANT**

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order approving a 320-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E/2W/2 of Section 34 and the E/2W/2 of Section 27, Township 21 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard unit. The unit is to be dedicated to the Bilbrey 34/27 B2NC Fed Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a surface location 185 feet from the south line and 2030 feet from the west line of Section 34, and a terminus 330 feet from the north line and 2100 feet from the west line of Section 27. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision,

designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
