

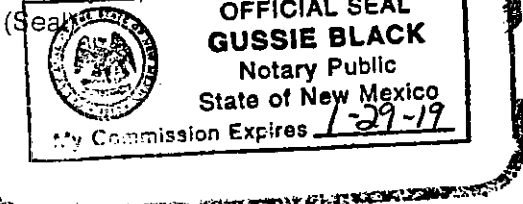

This is to notify all interested parties, including the Estate of Jewell Hosford, BC Operating, Inc., the Estate of Shirley Sue Mosley, the Estate of Joe Bill Mosley, the Estate of Eddie Mae Mosley, Energen Resources Corporation, Tilden Capital, LLC and their heirs, devisees, successors and assigns, that the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division will conduct a hearing in Case No. 15295 (re-opened) at 8:15 a.m. on July 21, 2016 in Porter Hall at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico. Applicant COG Operating LLC seeks an order (i) creating a 240-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) comprised of the W/2 E/2 of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 35 East and the W/2 SE/4 of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, in Lea County, and (ii) pooling all mineral interests in the WC-025 6-09 5243532M, Wolfbone Pool (pool code 98098) underlying this acreage. The project area is to be dedicated to applicant's Skull Cap Fed Com #22H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit J of Section 32, Township 24 South, Range 35 East to a bottom hole location in Unit O of Section 5, Township 25 South, Range 35 East. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, and completing the well and the allocation of the cost, the designation of COG Operating LLC as the operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The proposed project area is located approximately five miles west of Ochoa, New Mexico. #31055
