STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation, in the S/2 of Section 11, Township 16 South, Range 24 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico to form a 320-acre project area for a horizontal well. Said unit is to be dedicated to its Brazos "B" 11 Fee Well No. 1H to be horizontally drilled from a surface location 1730 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line to a depth of 5100 feet and then in a westerly direction for approximately 3986 feet in the

Wolfcamp formation to a bottomhole location 1880 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 11. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of EOG Resources, Inc. as operator of the well and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 9 miles northwest of Artesia, New Mexico.
