Pursuant to your request we have conducted research on the above referenced lands. Please find accompanying this cover letter; a written report and excel spreadsheet with our findings on the requested lands. A description of our methodology used to obtain the information can be found below.


The written report provides a list of all the mineral owners, surface owners, grazing lessees, federal leases, leasehold owners and operators of record within the one-mile radius of the AGI Zia #2 Well. The excel spreadsheet lists all relevant mineral leases along with their respective leasehold owners, operators, and well information. Full names and legal mailing addresses have been provided for any person or entity found to have an interest within the 1-mile radius.

The following methodology was performed to obtain the information:

1. Initial research was conducted online via the BLM website to examine the Master Title Plats and Oil & Gas Plats to identify the surface and mineral estates as federal, state or fee lands.
2. Once federal lands were identified, J Bar Cane, Inc. contracted Federal Abstract Company out of Santa Fe, N.M. to build reports on all federal mineral ownership as to all depths. There were no fee or state minerals in the lands on which we reported.
3. Title examination and research were performed on the referenced lands in the public records of Eddy and Lea Counties in New Mexico.
4. The title information provided by Federal Abstract Company was then tracked against the records of Lea and Eddy Counties to confirm there were no title discrepancies.
5. Surface ownership and grazing leases for the federal lands were reported on from the records provided in the "Land Records" section of the BLM website.
6. Surface ownership for the fee lands were reported on from the Lea County Assessor's Office in Lovington, NM.
7. Well information was compiled through examination of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division website, then tracked against the Eddy and Lea County records to verify accuracy.
8. Any addresses not found in the public records or provided by any governmental agency were found via internet research.
9. All information contained in the Federal Abstracts provided by Federal Abstract Company is current up to May 14, 2016.
10. All information found in the Eddy County and Lea County Public Records is current up to June 9, 2016.
