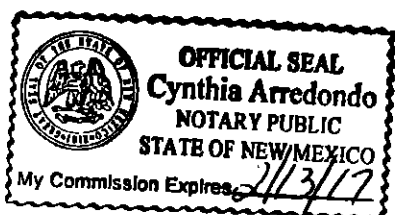

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a non-standard, 160-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the S/2 S/2 of Section 27, Township 17, South, Range 28, East, NMPM, Eddy County and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Glorieta and Yeso formations (Artesia; Glorieta Yeso Pool (96830)) from the top of the Glorieta to a depth of 4,000 feet underlying this acreage. Said non-standard unit is to be dedicated to applicant's proposed Halberd 27 State Com No. 1H Well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 26 to a standard bottom hole location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 27. The completed interval for this well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the rules. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of COG Operating LLC as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 15 miles east of Artesia, New Mexico.</p>
