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Page 2 (9:09 a.m.) 1 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Good morning. 2 This 3 is the meeting of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission. My name is David Catanach, chairman of the 4 Commission and director of the Oil Conservation 5 Division. 6 7 The time is about nine minutes after 9:00. Today's date is October 6, 2016. This meeting is being 8 conducted in Porter Hall within the Wendell Chino State 9 Building. At this time I will take roll. 10 11 Will the Commissioners please introduce themselves for the record? 12 COMMISSIONER MARTIN: Ed Martin 13 14 representing the State Land Office. COMMISSIONER BALCH: Dr. Robert Balch, 15 16 designee of the Secretary of Energy and Minerals. 17 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Thank you, Commissioners. 18 19 Also present is Bill Brancard, the Commission attorney and general counsel for the Energy, 20 21 Minerals and Natural Resources Department. 22 In your packet is the agenda for today's meeting. Is there a motion and a second to adopt 23 today's agenda? 24 I'd move to adopt the 25 COMMISSIONER BALCH:

Page 3 1 agenda. 2 COMMISSIONER MARTIN: Second. 3 All in favor? COMMISSIONER CATANACH: 4 (Ayes are unanimous.) COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Motion to adopt 5 6 today's agenda is passed. 7 Also in the packet is the September 6th and 7th, 2016 Commission meeting minutes. 8 9 Commissioners, do you have any -- have you reviewed the minutes, and do you have any changes to the 10 And if not, is there a motion and a second to 11 minutes? 12 adopt the minutes? 13 COMMISSIONER BALCH: I've reviewed the minutes and have no changes, and I would move to adopt 14 15 them. 16 COMMISSIONER MARTIN: No changes here 17 either, and I second. 18 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Okay. All in 19 favor? 20 (Ayes are unanimous.) 21 COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Motion to adopt the 22 minutes of the Commission meeting is passed. 23 One announcement at this time, for the benefit of the Commission, I just want to mention that 24 25 Targa Midstream Services, LLC is the operator of an

acid-gas injection unit, the Monument AGI, located near 1 2 Monument. The past several weeks, Targa has had 3 mechanical problems with the well and have made efforts 4 to repair the well. They have been unable to, so they 5 elected to plug and abandon the well. This well 6 services the area around Monument, and there are 7 probably a lot wells shut in or flaring gas at this time 8 because of that well being shut down. Targa is 9 proposing to drill two additional acid-gas wells in this 10 area in a quick fashion.

11 They've come to us and asked us if there 12 was an expedited process where they could get these two 13 new acid-gas wells approved. I've authorized them to go 14 to Division hearing with these two wells because I think 15 it's a quicker process.

16 I know the Commission docket is pretty full 17 the next few weeks, and so I just wanted to let the 18 Commission know that those two cases will be going to a 19 Division Examiner hearing for approval. I have full 20 confidence that the Division will, you know, follow the 21 quidelines that the Commission has established with regard to acid-gas injection wells. So I just wanted to 22 23 make you aware.

24 COMMISSIONER BALCH: They're drilling a new 25 well and a redundant well at this time?

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1	COMMISSIONER CATANACH: Correct. That's my
2	understanding.
3	COMMISSIONER BALCH: I suspect their
4	drilling locations will range in the area of review
5	significantly.
6	COMMISSIONER CATANACH: I'm not I'm not
7	certain what that is at this time, where the new
8	injection wells are, but they're in the same area, is my
9	understanding, and as deep. I think they're going to be
10	Devonian wells.
11	COMMISSIONER BALCH: Okay.
12	COMMISSIONER CATANACH: So that's what
13	we're doing with that.
