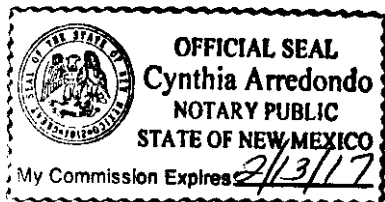

and approving an un-
orthodox gas well lo-
cation. The unit is to
be dedicated to the

face location 2450
feet from the south
line and 450 feet from
the west line of Sec-
tion 33, and a termi-
nus 330 feet from the
south line and 450
