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Page 3 1 (8:23 a.m.) 2 EXAMINER DAWSON: So we will -- at this 3 point I would like to introduce, to my left, Examiner Will Jones. 4 5 My name is Scott Dawson. I'm the Chief 6 Examiner. 7 And to my right is our attorney, David 8 Brooks. 9 So we will start with the first case, Case 10 Number 15531. This is continued from the September 29th, 2016 Examiner Hearing, and it's the application of 11 12 M & M Energy, LLC for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. 13 14 At this point I would like to call for 15 appearances. 16 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of 17 Santa Fe representing the Applicant. I am submitting 18 this case by affidavit. 19 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. Any other 20 appearances? 21 Okay. Mr. Bruce, you may continue when 22 you're ready. 23 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I've handed you 24 three exhibits. The first one is a verified statement 25 of Alan White, a contract landman for the Applicant in

this case. The Applicant seeks an order to force pool 1 all mineral interests from the surface to the base of 2 3 the San Andres Formation in the northeast quarter-southwest quarter of Section 6, Township 22 4 5 South, Range 36 East, to form a standard 40-acre oil 6 spacing and proration unit. The unit will be dedicated 7 to the Day Well #9, to be located at an orthodox location. This is fee land. There are about 60 mineral 8 owners, and Applicant is seeking to force pool about 20 9 of those. 10 11 As you go through the attachments, the first attachment, A, is just an outline of the well 12 13 unit. An APD has not been filed. The planned location 14 at this point is 1,650 feet from the south line and 2,100 feet from the west line. I looked -- I will get 15 you information on the pools involved as to those 16 17 depths. Exhibit B is the list of the interest 18 owners being pooled and percentage interests. Most are 19 20 quite small, except for the interests of Apache Corporation and Samson Resources. 21 22 Attachment C are the unlocatable parties. 23 All of the other 55-plus interest owners were located. 24 Exhibit D is a form letter that was sent to all of the -- the last letter that was sent to all of 25

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the unleased mineral owners -- they were all unleased 1 2 mineral owners -- requesting them to join in the well 3 either by lease or by participating in the well. And Attachment E is an AFE for the well, 4 5 which is about \$1.7 million. 6 As to the interest owners, the Court has 7 searched -- M & M researched the county records and Internet searches, et cetera, and all but about 5 out of 8 60 -- 5 or 6 out of 60-plus mineral owners were located. 9 10 When you see the Affidavit of Notice, there are four 11 some returned mails, but as Mr. White states in his affidavit, they have had contacts with everyone other 12 13 than the people listed on Exhibit C. 14 And M & M does request a 200 percent risk 15 charge and requests administrative charges of \$6,000 for drilling the well and \$600 a month for producing the 16 17 well. Exhibit 2 is my Affidavit of Notice. Т 18 sent out letters, a couple of batches of letters, and 19 20 green cards or letters or copies of them are attached. 21 As to the parties who did not claim their certified mail or even when the post office records show 22 23 the mail was delivered, there is one or two green cards 24 I never got back. This is after two months' time, so I published notice as against all of the persons who did 25

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Page 6 not receive the certified mail or I never got the green 1 cards back, and that's marked as Exhibit 3. 2 3 And with that, I will move the admission of Exhibits 1 through 3 and ask that this matter be taken 4 5 under advisement. 6 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. Exhibits 1 through 7 3 will be so admitted. 8 (M & M Energy, LLC Exhibit Numbers 1 9 through 3 are offered and admitted into 10 evidence.) 11 EXAMINER DAWSON: Do you have any 12 questions? EXAMINER JONES: No. 13 EXAMINER DAWSON: Any questions? 14 15 EXAMINER BROOKS: Yeah. You said you 16 sent -- you published for everybody that you didn't get -- that you don't have a green card received? 17 18 MR. BRUCE: Correct. 19 EXAMINER BROOKS: And that's your Exhibit 20 3, which is the Notice of Publication? 21 MR. BRUCE: Correct. 22 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. This is a vertical 23 well? Those are getting unusual these days. 24 MR. BRUCE: I think I'm the only one that does them. 25

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1		EXAMINER BROOKS: It's on a 40-acre
2		MR. BRUCE: It's 40-acre.
3		EXAMINER BROOKS: That's all I think I need
4	to ask.	
5		EXAMINER DAWSON: I have no questions.
6		MR. BRUCE: With that, I'm out of here.
7		EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. So Case Number
8	15531 will be	taken under advisement.
