Our records reflect that Celero Energy II, LP is operating the North Caprock Celero Queen Unit area, Lea County, New Mexico.

Our records reflect the following:

- The North Caprock Celero Queen Unit Agreement was approved effective October 31, 2012.
- The date of last production from this unit was May 20, 2015.
- Article 18.1 Term states the following: "the term of this agreement shall be for the time that
 unitized substances are produced in paying quantities and so long thereafter as Operations are
 conducted without a cessation of more than one hundred eighty (180) consecutive days, unless
 sooner terminated by Working Interest Owners in the manner herein provided."
