APPLICATION

Matador Production Company applies for an order pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the S½ of Section 11, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and approving an unorthodox gas well location, and in support thereof, states:

1. Applicant is an operator in the S¹/₂ of Section 11, and has the right to drill a well thereon.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its Michael Collins 11-23S-27E RB Well No. 208H to a depth sufficient to test the Wolfcamp formation. Applicant seeks to dedicate the well to the S½ of Section 11 to form a standard 320 acre gas spacing and proration unit in the Wolfcamp formation. The well is a horizontal well, with a surface location in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 11. The first perforation is 330 feet from the south and east lines, and last perforation is 330 feet from the south and west lines, of Section 11. The producing interval of the well is orthodox.

3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the S½ of Section 11 for the purposes set forth herein.

4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the S½ of Section 11, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.

5. The pooling of all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the S¹/₂ of Section 11 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

A. Pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the S¹/₂ of Section 11;

B. Designating applicant as operator of the well;

C. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating its cost among the well's working interest owners;

D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
