Jordan:

I need some clarification from your client on the true location of the well, specifically the bottom-hole (BH) location, as provided in hearing in contrast with the information filed with District. The C-102 provided as Exhibit A for this case shows a BHL of 330 feet from the south line of Sec. 3, T26S, R33E, NMPM. Testimony by COG's witness has stated that the well's completed interval will have standard setbacks (which addressed the SL with the 210-foot distance from the north line of Sec. 34, T25S, R33E, NMPM).

COG has filed a current C-102 (dated August 8, 2016) shows a BHL of 50 feet from the south line of Sec. 3 [see attachment]. This being the applicant's most current C-102 which postdates (by nearly a year) the exhibit presented in hearing, what is the BHL location of the <u>completed interval</u> for this well? This will impact whether the order will include a requirement for a NSL application to be completed. Call with any questions. Thanks. PRG
