<u>APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE</u>

In Case No. 15667, EOG seeks an order (1) creating a 240-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 10, and the W/2 SW/4 of Section 3, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; (2) approving an unorthodox location for the wellbore; and (3) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying this acreage. EOG proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing and proration unit as the project area for its proposed **Osprey 10 No. 602H**, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 10 to a bottom hole location in NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 3. The project area is located within theRed Hills; Bone Spring, East (97369), which is subject to statewide rules for oil pools and requires wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit. The completed interval for this well will commence 330 feet from the South line, 1,270 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 10 to a location 2,304 feet from the South line, 1,270 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 3. The completed interval therefore encroaches on the spacing and proration units to the East and Northeast.

In Case No. 15666, EOG seeks an order (1) creating a 240-acre spacing and proration unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 10, and the W/2 SW/4 of Section 3, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying this acreage. EOG proposes to dedicate the spacing and proration unit as the project area for its proposed **Osprey 10 No. 701H**, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 10 to a bottom hole location in NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 3. The project area is located within the WC-

025-G-09-S253402N; Wolfcamp Pool (98116)), and the completed interval for this well will remain within the 330-foot standard offset required by the statewide rules.
