Pursuant to the notice provisions contained in 19 15 4 NMAC, you are hereby notified that at 8 15 AM on February 2; 2017, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("QCD") will hold a hearing in front of a Division Examiner seeking an order determining that the Elmira T Welch ("Operator") (1) is out of compliance with 19 15 5 9, 19 15 8, and 19 15 25 8 NMAC, (2) requiring Operator to return to compliance with 19 15 5 9, 19 15 8, and 19 15 25 8 NMAC, and (3) in the event of non-compliance, finding the Operator in violation of a Division Order for each day after the deadline established in the sought order to obtain compliance, declaring the well abandoned, and authorizing the OCD to plug the violating well in accordance with a Division-approved plugging program and restore and remediate the location, recover costs from the Operator's financial assurance as permitted by 19 15 8 13 NMAC, and seek indemnification as permitted by NMSA 1978, § 70-2-14(E) The hearing will be held in Porter Hall at 1220 South St Francis Dr, Santa Fe, New Mexico
