APPLICANT

Case No. 17723: Application of Owl SWD Operating, LLC for authorization to inject water for disposal into the Yates-Seven Rivers formation Lea County, New Mexico; Applicant seeks an order approving the use of the Bobcat SWD No. 1 for the injection of water into the Yates-Seven Rivers formation at the intervals and the pressures, volumes and rates detailed in its Application. Owl currently injects into the Maralo Sholes B Well No. 2 under the authority of Administrative Order SWD-1127 and intends for the Bobcat SWD No. 1 well to replace the Maralo Sholes B Well No. 2. Applicant proposes to drill this new well to a total depth of approximately 3,060 feet, for

injection of water into the Yates-Seven Rivers formation by open hole from 2,915 to 3060 feet. The well is located SW of Jal, NM.

OPPONENT NEW MEXICO STATE LAND OFFICE

The SLO is opposed to this replacement well being drilled as a SWD into the same zone as the Maralo Sholes Well No. 2, since the Tansill, Yates-Seven Rivers zones, as well as the Capitan Reef, contain protectable groundwater of the State of New Mexico in this area.
