To: Petrorep Inc. and Corexcal, or their successors: Mewbourne Oil Company has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division

seeking an order approving a 640 acre non-standard spacing and proration unit in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the W/2 of Section 22 and the W/2 of Section 27, Township 26 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, pooling all mineral interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying the non-standard spacing and proration unit, and approving an unorthodox gas well location. The unit is to be dedicated to the Owl Draw 27/22 W2NC Fed. Com. Well No. 2H, a horizontal well with a surface location 170 feet from the south line and 2230 feet from the west line of Section 27, and a terminus 330 feet from the north line and 2310 feet from the west line of Section 22. The beginning and end of the producing interval will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 13-1/2 miles south-southeast of Black River Village, New Mexico. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, February 16, 2017 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date. The attorney for applicant is James Bruce, P.O. Box 1056, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504. The unit is located approximately 13-1/2 miles south-southeast of Black River Village, New Mexico.


