- 2 EXAMINER DAWSON: At this time we're back
- 3 at hearing on Docket Number 19-17. We will continue the
- 4 hearing and go on to the last two cases.
- 5 The first case we will hear is 15705,
- 6 application of New Mexico Oil Conservation Division
- 7 Compliance and Enforcement Bureau for a compliance order
- 8 against Southwestern, Incorporated, for wells operated
- 9 in Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico.
- 10 Mr. Herrmann, you may present your witness.
- MR. HERRMANN: Mr. Examiner, Keith Herrmann
- 12 representing the Compliance and Enforcement Bureau of
- 13 the Oil Conservation Division.
- 14 The Compliance and Enforcement Bureau is
- 15 seeking a compliance order for assurance violations
- 16 against the operator, Southwestern, Incorporated. They
- 17 have three wells in Lea and Eddy Counties that require
- 18 additional financial assurance.
- The OCD has one witness, Ms. Denise
- 20 Gallegos.
- 21 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. Ms. Gallegos, can
- 22 you please get sworn in by the court reporter?
- DENISE GALLEGOS,
- 24 after having been first duly sworn under oath, was
- 25 questioned and testified as follows:

- 1 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. Mr. Herrmann, you
- 2 can proceed.
- 3 MR. HERRMANN: Thank you.
- 4 DIRECT EXAMINATION
- 5 BY MR. HERRMANN:
- 6 Q. Ms. Gallegos, please state your name, title and
- 7 place of employment for the record.
- 8 A. Denise Gallegos, compliance officer with the
- 9 New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.
- 10 Q. And could you briefly described the duties you
- 11 perform for the Oil Conservation Division?
- 12 A. Among other duties, I'm responsible for
- 13 management, enforcement and ensuring compliance of the
- 14 Division's Financial Assurance Program.
- 15 Q. And are you familiar with the violations
- 16 detailed in this application for hearing?
- 17 A. Yes.
- Q. Could you please identify the operator that is
- 19 the subject of this compliance case and their OGRID?
- 20 A. Southwestern, Incorporated, OGRID Number 21386.
- 21 Q. And how many wells do they operate and in what
- 22 counties are they located in?
- 23 A. Three wells, Eddy and Lea Counties.
- Q. Does the Division post all inactive wells,
- 25 otherwise known as temporarily abandoned status, for an

- 1 operator on its Web site?
- 2 A. Yes. It's available on OCD's Web site. It's
- 3 updated daily, and it's a well list, listing each well
- 4 by operator.
- 5 Q. Does the OCD require additional financial
- 6 assurance for wells inactive over two years?
- 7 A. Yes.
- Q. And what is the amount of financial assurance?
- 9 A. The amount is based on what county the well's
- 10 in and the measured depth of the well.
- 11 Q. And what is the financial assurance required
- 12 for wells in Eddy and Lea Counties?
- 13 A. A base of \$5,000.
- 14 Q. And?
- 15 A. A dollar per foot of the measured depth.
- 16 Q. Thank you.
- How many of this operator's wells need
- 18 additional financial assurance?
- 19 A. Three.
- Q. Could you identify the wells and the amounts
- 21 needed? And use Exhibit 1 for reference.
- 22 A. Humble State #1, API 30-015-01900, in the
- 23 amount of \$7,502; Humble State #2, API 30-015-01969, in
- 24 the amount of \$7,433; and State VC #1, API 30-025-03035,
- 25 in the amount of \$14,075.

- Q. Was the operator notified of these violations?
- 2 A. Yes.
- 3 Q. When?
- 4 A. A Notice of Financial Assurance Violation
- 5 letter was mailed out certified mail on June 30th, 2016,
- 6 and a signed green card was received by the OCD on July
- 7 7th, 2016.
- 8 O. And?
- 9 A. As of today, I haven't received any response
- 10 from the operator.
- 11 Q. And is Exhibit 2 a copy of that notice?
- 12 A. Yes.
- Q. What relief is the Division requesting?
- 14 A. The Division is requesting the operator provide
- 15 the OCD with acceptable financial assurance within 30
- 16 days of issuance of an order of finding that the
- 17 operator is in violation of 70-2-14 of the New Mexico
- 18 State Statutes and 19.15.8 NMAC, and if the operator
- 19 does not post the requested financial assurance within
- 20 30 days of the issuance of an order, that the operator
- 21 is in violation of the Division order.
- Q. Is the OCD only seeking to enforce violations
- 23 of financial requirements at this hearing?
- 24 A. Yes.
- Q. Were Exhibits 1 and 2 prepared by you or under

- 1 your direction?
- 2 A. Yes.
- 3 MR. HERRMANN: Mr. Examiner, I have no
- 4 further questions at this time.
- I would move to admit OCD Exhibits 1 and 2
- 6 and, in addition, OCD Exhibit 3, which is an Affidavit
- 7 of Service that was prepared by myself that includes a
- 8 copy of the certified mailing to the operator's address
- 9 that we have on file and an Affidavit of Publication in
- 10 the "Artesia Daily Press" and the "Lovington Leader,"
- 11 newspapers of general circulation in Lea and Eddy
- 12 Counties.
- 13 EXAMINER DAWSON: Okay. Exhibits 1 and 2,
- 14 and the Affidavit of Service, which is Exhibit 3; the
- 15 certified mail return receipt -- Exhibit 3A, the direct
- 16 notice to the operator, the green cards and the copy of
- 17 publication in the "Artesia Daily Press" will all be
- 18 admitted to the record.
- MR. HERRMANN: And also "The Lovington
- 20 Leader, "sir.
- 21 EXAMINER DAWSON: I'm sorry. And also "The
- 22 Lovington Leader." That will be admitted to the record,
- 23 the Affidavit of Publication for "The Lovington Leader."
- 24 They'll all be admitted into the record.
- 25 (NMOCD Compliance and Enforcement Bureau

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1	Exhibit Numbers 1, 2, 3, 3A, 3B are
2	offered and admitted into evidence.)
3	MR. HERRMANN: Thank you. That concludes
4	our presentation.
5	EXAMINER DAWSON: Do you have any
6	questions, Mr. Brooks?
7	EXAMINER BROOKS: No questions.
8	I remember bringing a compliance action
9	against this same operator quite a few years ago. Just
10	an observation.
11	MR. HERRMANN: I haven't found that one.
12	EXAMINER DAWSON: So with that, Case Number
13	15705 will be taken under advisement.
