Lucid Energy Delaware LLC requests modifications from the NM Oil Conservation Commission Order R-13507 authorizing it to inject acid gas and carbon dioxide (CO₂) from the Red Hills Gas Processing Plant into its drilled but uncompleted Red Hills AGI#1 well. The well is located in Section 13, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, in Lea County, New Mexico. Lucid requests Order modifications to reflect: 1) the change of operator from the former operator Agave Energy Company to Lucid Energy Delaware LLC; 2) a re-establishment of the authority to inject, extended until January 2019; and, 3) an adjustment of the original injection zone from approximately 6200 feet to 6530 feet to 6,230 feet to 6,585 feet to reflect more detailed geological information obtained during drilling of the Red Hills AGI # 1. The Red Hills AGI #1 is located approximately twenty (20) miles northwest of the town of Jal, New Mexico.
