STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Mewbourne's application seeks an order (i) approving a 640-acre, more or less, non-standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the S/2 of Section 5 and the S/2 of Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 27 East, N.M.P.M., in Eddy County, and (ii) pooling all uncommitted working interests in the Wolfcamp formation.

The proposed non-standard spacing and proration unit will be the project area for the Wolfman 5/4 WoLI Federal Com #1H well, which will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Unit L of Section 5 to a bottom hole location in Unit I of Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 27 East. The completed interval for the well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
