

The new pool will include Section 36 of Township 22 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Sections 31 and 32 of Township 22 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Sections 1 and 12 of Township 23 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, and Sections 5-8 of Township 23 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. The special rules will include standard 480 acre oil spacing and proration units, special well location requirements, an increased depth bracket allowable for a standard 480 acre unit, and a gas:oil ratio of 5000:1. The applications are scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, October 12, 2017 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the subject lands you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the cases. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting these matters at a later date.
