## **APPLICATION**

EOG Resources, Inc. ("EOG") through its undersigned attorneys, files this application with the Oil Conservation Division for an order approving an approximately 640-acre non-standard spacing unit in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of the E/2 of Section 14 and the E/2 of Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, NMPM Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, EOG states:

- 1. EOG (OGRID No. 7377) is the only working interest owner in federal leases covering the E/2 of Section 14 and the E/2 of Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, NMPM Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2. EOG has drilled or permitted the following horizontal wells in the Sanders Tank; Upper Wolfcamp Pool (Pool Code 98097) underlying the subject acreage:
  - The Dogwood 23 Fed Com No. 701H Well (API No. 30-025-44073) and the Dogwood Fed Com No. 702H Well (API No. 30-025-44074) in the E/2 E/2 of Sections 14 and 23; and
  - The Dogwood 23 Fed Com No. 703H Well (API No. 30-025-44075) and the Dogwood Fed Com No. 704H Well (API No. 30-025-44095) in the W/2 E/2 of Sections 14 and 23.

3. The Sanders Tank; Upper Wolfcamp Pool (Pool Code 98097) is subject to the Division's statewide rules providing for 40-acre spacing units. EOG's drilling program for the subject acreage will develop each of the 40-acre tracts comprising the proposed non-standard spacing unit.

4. To fully develop the acreage and to maximize spacing efficiency, EOG seeks approval to develop the subject acreage as a non-standard spacing unit.

5. Pursuant to Rule 19.15.15.11, EOG will provide notice of this application to the persons affected by EOG's request for a non-standard spacing unit.

6. Approval of this application is in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, EOG requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 8, 2018, and that after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order granting this application.

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order approving an approximately 640-acre non-standard spacing unit in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of the E/2 of Section 14 and the E/2 of Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 33 East, NMPM Lea County, New Mexico. This acreage has been placed in the Sanders Tank; Upper Wolfcamp Pool (Pool Code 98097) and is subject to the Division's general statewide rules for oil development. This subject area is located approximately 5 miles west of Andrews Place, New Mexico.
