STATEMENT OF THE CASE

COG seeks an order from the Division (1) creating a 320-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 24 and the E/2 W/2 of Section 25, Township 25 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico; and (2) pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation. COG seeks to dedicate this non-standard spacing and proration unit to its proposed **Road Runner Fed Com No. 3H Well** and the proposed **Road Runner Fed Com No. 13H Well**, which will be simultaneously drilled and completed. These

wells are stacked laterals and that will be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 25 to a standard bottom hole location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 24.
