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Application of Delaware Energy LLC for Authorization to Inject Salt Water for Purposes of Disposal Through its Moomaw SWD No. 1 Well, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order authorizing injection of salt water for purposes of disposal through its proposed Moomaw SWD No. 1 well with a surface location 1,646 feet from the north line and 2,294 feet from the east line (Unit G) of Section 25, Township 24 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. The maximum proposed daily injection rate will be 30,000 barrels per day with an average injection rate of 15,000 to 20,000 barrels per day. The proposed injection will occur within the Devonian-Fusselman Formations from 17,400 to 19,200 feet deep. The maximum surface injection pressure will be 3,480 psi with an average injection pressure of 1,800 psi. Said well is located approximately 9 miles northwest of Jal, New Mexico.
