EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay, at this time I'll call Case 13,683, which is the Application of Patina San Juan for an unorthodox gas well location, San Juan County, New Mexico.

Call for appearances.

MR. HALL: Mr. Examiner, Scott Hall, Miller Stratvert P.A., Santa Fe, appearing on behalf of Patina San Juan, Incorporated. No witnesses.

EXAMINER CATANACH: Any additional appearances?

Okay, there being none, Mr. Hall, you may proceed.

MR. HALL: Mr. Examiner, this case began as an administrative application for approval of an unorthodox well location for the Valence 33 Number 2 well to be completed in the Fruitland Coal and Dakota formations at a surface location 320 feet from the north line and 2145 feet from the east line, Section 33, 31 North, 13 West. The reasons for the request were, topographic conditions on the surface precluded a standard location due to the existence of river and wetlands, nearby wetlands.

The well is the first Fruitland Coal well in the east half of the section and will be the second infill Dakota formation well.

The Application was filed on January 24th, 2006.

Notice was provided to offset operators in accordance with the Rule. After the 20-day period for stating objections had run, the Division received an objection letter from a surface owner. We filed an objection to that and moved to dismiss the surface owner's objection and challenge the surface owner's standing to assert an objection.

Since that time, the surface owner has provided

Since that time, the surface owner has provided us and the Division with a letter waiving their objection, and so that issue is now mooted.

We accordingly request that the Application now be processed pursuant to a Hearing Examiner order, and we understand that the Division would like to see additional evidence with respect to the location of the wetlands and how they infringe on the -- a standard surface location.

We'll certainly provide that to you after the hearing.

EXAMINER CATANACH: Okay. I can confirm also that we did receive a letter in which the surface owners have withdrawn their objection to this Application, and therefore I believe it can be processed at this time.

If you will provide the Division that additional information after the hearing, Mr. Hall, we will process the Application.

And do you have anything further?

MR. HALL: That's it.
