## <u>APPLICATION FOR COMPULSORY POOLING, NON-STANDARD</u> <u>SPACING AND PRORATION UNIT, AND UNORTHODOX LOCATION</u>

PRIDE ENERGY COMPANY applies for an order pooling all mineral interests within the vertical limits of the Wolfcamp formation (Pool Code 98270), non-standard spacing and proration unit, and unorthodox location, underlying the W/2E/2 of Section 16, Township 25 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, Applicant states:

- 1. Applicant is an interest owner in the W/2E/2 of Section 16, and has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Paduca 16 State 702H well to be located at a non-standard well location having a surface location 200 FNL and 2175 FEL of Section 16 and a bottom hole location of 330 FSL and 1680 FEL.
- 3. Applicant seeks to dedicate the W/2E/2 of Section 16 to the well to form a non-standard 160 acre spacing and proration unit within the vertical limits of the Wolfcamp formation.
- 4. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the W/2E/2 of Section 16 for the purposes set forth herein.

- 5. Certain mineral owners have failed or refused to join in the drilling of the proposed well, therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the W/2E/2 of Section 16 pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17 as requested in this application.
- 6. The pooling of all mineral interests as requested in this application underlying the W/2E/2 of Section 16 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the W/2E/2 of Section 16 within the vertical limits of the Wolfcamp formation.
- B. Approving this application with respect to non-standard spacing and proration unit and unorthodox location.
  - C. Designating Applicant as the operator of the well;
- D. Considering the cost of completing the well, and allocating the cost among the well's working interest owners;
- E. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and,
- F. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
