
**BTA's MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**

BTA Oil Producers, LLC ("BTA") moves to continue the hearing in this case to the May 31, 2018 docket, and in support thereof, states;

1. In this case OneEnergy Partners, LLC seeks to pool the W/W/2 of Section 4, Township 24 South, Range 35 East, N.M.P.M., in Lea County. The matter is set for hearing on the May 3<sup>rd</sup> docket.
2. BTA owns approximately 50% of the working interest in the well unit, and has previously proposed a well to OneEnergy.
3. BTA will be filing a counter-application to pool the W/2W/2 of Section 4 no later than May 1, 2018. Under Division notice deadlines, the matter will be set for the May 31<sup>st</sup> docket.
4. It is the Division's informal policy to set cases dealing with the same subject matter on the same docket, to avoid having two hearings on the same subject. Therefore, BTA requests that Case No. 16108 be continued to May 31<sup>st</sup>.
5. BTA has contacted counsel for OneEnergy about this request, but OneEnergy has refused to consent to this motion.

WHEREFORE, BTA requests that the Division continue Case No. 16108 to the May 31<sup>st</sup> docket.


